LRCCC – Covid-Secure Guidelines as of 23rd June 2020

(These guidelines are correct at the date of publishing and are subject to change in line with government advise)

- LRCCC wish to keep all BL members as safe as possible and these guidelines are designed to give Covid-Secure procedures for all LRCCC rallies at the present time.
- The numbers attending the rally will be closely monitored to ensure there is sufficient distance between units to maintain safe social distancing.
- Payment for rallies will only be accepted by contactless card method. No cash payments will be accepted on the rally field.
- No front sheets or competitions will be given out to minimise person to person contact. On arrival at the site, any information will be verbally communicated.
- No other cash will be taken on the rally as there will be no raffle, bonus ball, merchandise, bingo or tuckshop.
- There will be no organised socials, coffee morning or food & drink supplied on the rally.
- Members must maintain the recommended social distancing and gatherings should be at the level currently set by the government.
- It is permissible for members to sit under gazebos outside their unit, but gazebos must be taken down overnight, and not left unattended at any time.
- Members must not share food, drinks, cooking/food utensils or BBQs.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for their children at all times and must ensure they are following the Covid-Secure guidelines.
- No day visitors will be permitted. Only those booked onto the rally can attend, as to comply with Track & Trace.
- Members must practise effective hand washing on a regular basis.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at the rally marshals unit.
- Sanitising equipment will be provided at the water and elsan points and members must clean all touch points before and after use.
- All BL members are expected to adhere to the LRCCC Covid-Secure guidelines and the current government guidelines. Anyone not respecting the guidance will be spoken to by the rally marshal or committee member and persistent offences will result in the member being asked to leave.
- LRCCC expect their members to show due respect for one another by following the guidance to keep everyone as safe as possible.
- If you feel unwell with suspected Covid symptoms DO NOT attend the rally.
- If anyone develops symptoms onsite their unit must immediately self-isolate. The rally marshals must be informed (preferably by phone/FB). The affected unit must only use common points at a time arranged with the marshal who will ensure areas are disinfected after use. Any rubbish from the affected unit must be double bagged and taken home. The affected unit should leave the site as soon as is safely possible.
